**IN ADDENDANCE:** Brian Nanns, Melissa Nanns, Mike Brown, Nancy Brown, Jenna Lamour, Brad Stone

Approval of Minutes from 9.15.22

**MEMBERSHIP UPDATE:** 43 members

Ways to increase membership – create a flyer, make announcement at football game (discount game day)

**BUSINESS FROM PREVIOUS MEETING:**

- Transfer of official books to ABC Treasurer, Melissa Nanns
- New signers added to bank account 9/27/22, new debit cards given
- Approval procedure for spending – request/proposal must be in writing. Under \$500 don't need board vote, go to Lamour for approval, board is notified, treasurer cuts check. Over \$500 requires a board vote for approval.
- Decals – ordered 250, cost \$5...sell at games/concessions and split profits
- Hats – ordered 30 total (15 red/white, 15 grey/red), cost \$15 each (no profit)
- Shirts – ordered 10 each (S/M/L/XL), cost \$15 each (\$7.75 profit)
- Set up links for teams to pay fees through ABC website

**GENERAL FUND UPDATE:**

- Balance \$102,720.55, outstanding checks \$1467.90
- Reconciliation sheets will be done for games and for each team
- PE – split PE from general account so funds are kept separate
- Soccer – funds shirt purchase for girls team was pulled from boys account, will use money from general fund to replace money in boys account.
- ROTC – temporary sub account
- Homecoming game: \$1611.46 net
- 35% is the stocking fee going forward (gross profit – 35% then split)

**NEW BUSINESS:**

- Welcome Jenna Lamour as new AP of Athletics at Freedom
- By Laws – go through by laws – will vote to adopt Friday 10/28
- Senior Night – vote yes to purchase gifts for seniors from team account
- Concessions for other sports- scale down, coffee/hot chocolate, chips, drinks, non heated items
- Volunteers? – offer to team first, then to clubs? Offer volunteer hours
- End of year banquet – Boosters host Fall, Winter, Spring banquet for teams and families
  - Patriot Award for each team – chosen by coach
  - Letters/pins – Boosters will provide for athletes
  - Fall Sport Banquet...tickets, cater, date for beginning of December
- Vote yes to approve \$3490 from general fund - School Pride - Record Board for Gym for Athletes
- Football – needs new shed – get proposal

**FUTURE BUSINESS:**

- Paperwork Clinic – offer physicals, notary, insurance....find way to offset...approach booster members to help cover costs of insurance
- Group Booster Fundraising – ideas?
  - Casino Night...rent out country club
  - Partner with dealership – test driving cars etc
- Freedom Alumni Club
- Concessions/Parking – do a draft for selecting dates
